Parents Right to Know Elementary and Secondary Education Act

Title I Targeted Assistance Program

Pine Forest Charter School must notify parents of students attending the PFCS Title I Targeted Assistance Program that parents may request information on the professional qualifications of the student's teacher. The information must state if

- the teacher meets State Qualifications/licensure requirements,
- the teacher is teaching under an Emergency Teaching Certificate,
- the teacher has a baccalaureate degree,
- the child receives services from a paraprofessional and
- the qualifications of the paraprofessional.

Parents may request this information from the front office at 2257 E. Cedar Avenue, Flagstaff AZ 86004

Parents/Guardians of students in the Title I program will be notified at the annual parent meeting of the parents Right to Know.
